Cumulative Returns Since Inception

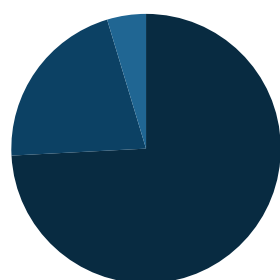

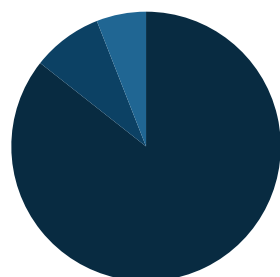

Sector Allocation

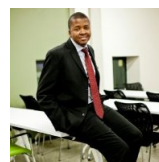

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Monthly Commentary

The SA listed Property sector (SAPY) lost 12.85% in the month of February. This performance is attributable to both sector specific and general global equity market conditions. The selloff in the Resilient group of property companies which started a month ago following allegations of improper business practices continued into February. The VIX index, which is used by investors globally to measure market risk, increased by 67% during the month following signs of the return of inflation. These concerns about inflation pushed global equity markets into correction resulting in share prices moving down globally. Lately investor sentiment seemed to have improved as global central banks try to provide more certainty regarding the prospects of inflation.

Glossary summary

Annualised performance: Annualised performance shows longer term performance rescaled to a 1 year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

Highest & Lowest return: The highest and lowest returns for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown.
